

#1 Weekly Update, Missing Assignments, as of September 5, 2019

Hello, Sections 1 and 2,

I don't usually E-mail the class unless it is really important. But, since we are just starting the semester I just want you to be aware of information you can use to keep up to speed with everything. I do my best to keep you informed along the way of how you are doing so you don't fall behind. If you keep up with all your work, you should be okay.

I am going to be posting weekly status updates of missing assignments at the end of each week that you can access on the Updates Page. All assignments have a point value. If you don't hand in an assignment then it will be listed with a negative point value until I get the assignment, using your student ID.

So, check the Updates Page at least once over the weekend. And, if you have something missing, hand it in ASAP. IF I have you down as not handing in an assignment and you did and I graded it, then bring in the graded assignment so I can update my gradebook.

In the event you are absent when an assignment comes due, it will be considered late if you hand it in after the due date. However, if there is a legitimate reason for missing class and you can produce a note, then I will waive the late penalty. It will make it easier for you to hand in late assignments with an excuse note, if you have one. If you know ahead of time you won't be in class you can always hand in the assignment early to avoid the late penalty.

To earn the maximum points possible, make an effort to hand in assignments early or on the date due. Late penalties apply to all required assignments. Hand in extra-credit assignments within the same section the required assignment is due, or along with the required assignment on the due date, if you finish the required assignment early. However, you will have till the last due date to hand in extra-credit papers.

If you come in late to class, make sure I get the assignments due for that day, as the first thing I do for each class is collect homework assignments, after I take attendance. **I will also be locking the classroom 10 minutes after the class starts, for purposes of safety, so be on time! I will talk more about this soon.**

Invest in a stapler! $\frac{1}{4}$ point may not sound like much, but it adds up. Let's say if you need to staple all 15 worksheet assignments and you don't, that's 3.25 points!

REMINDER: For all worksheets, make sure specific totals are noted. In most self-scoring worksheets you will need to add up scores, etc. Half a point if the exact total is not included and I have to do the math for you.

Especially for Worksheets #3, #4, #5 - please write down the exact total points you scored rather than just circle the range provided at the end of these worksheets.

Since you can earn 70 points for worksheets, do miss out by not completing them in their entirety. If there is a self-reflection section, complete that. If there's an Internet activity, complete that!

Check the calendar and assignments of what will come due for the coming week!
